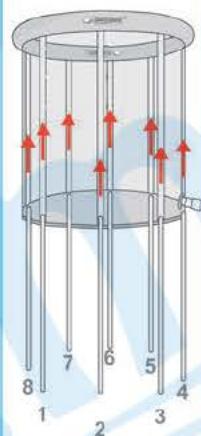
- * Suitable for infants aged 1 month onwards.
- * Use only under constant competent adult supervision.
- * Consult a pediatrician for suitability of this product for your infant before use.
- * Never leave an infant unattended while using the Swimava Compact Baby Pool and Starter Ring. Always remain within arm's reach.
- * Use mild soap and warm water to clean this product prior to use.
- * The Air Pump and Hose included with this product are not toys and may have detachable parts. Keep away from infants and children.

PRODUCT CARE AND STORAGE

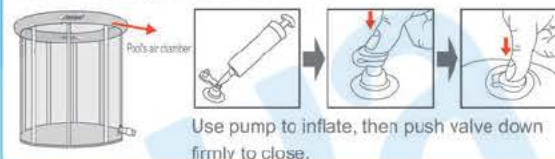
- * Keep the Swimava Compact Baby Pool and Starter Ring away from sharp or pointed objects, any sources of heat, and extended direct sunlight to avoid damage.
- * Regularly inspect the Swimava Compact Baby Pool and Starter Ring for any damage/punctures that could lead to deflation while in use.
- * Use only mild soap and warm water to clean this product. Do not pressure-wash this product and avoid use of any cleaning detergents, especially abrasives and bleach.

BEFORE USE

1 INSERT 1 pole in each of the 8 pockets around the pool, starting from the bottom



2 INFLATE the pool's air chamber



Use pump to inflate, then push valve down firmly to close.

3 CLOSE the drain



Make sure the pool drain is closed. Close the drain by twisting it clockwise until tight.

4 FILL the pool with water and TEST the water temperature

- Fill the Swimava Compact Baby Pool with warm water.
- Adjust the water level so your infant can float and enjoy free movement of his arms and legs in the water while the Swimava Starter Ring acts as a gentle support keeping the head above water. (See Fig.1)

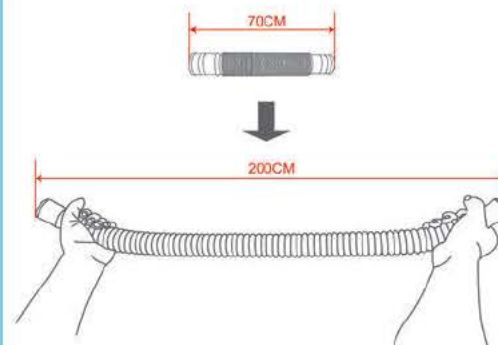
- * The water temperature should be approximately 35 degrees Celsius (95 degrees Fahrenheit) with no more than +/- 2 degrees Celsius (+/- 3.6 degrees Fahrenheit) variation. Monitor the water temperature with a floating baby thermometer.



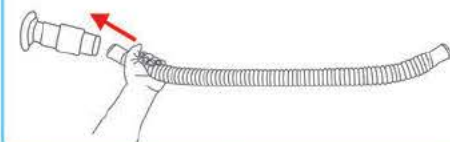

AFTER USE

1 EXTEND the water hose to preferable length (minum 70cm, maximum 200cm)



2 ATTACH the hose to the pool drain

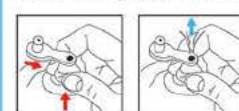


3 OPEN the drain



Open the pool drain by twisting it counter clockwise. The water will drain to your desired location.

4 DEFLATE the pool's air chamber



Once the water is removed, deflate the pool's air chamber
